
We will continue to make strategic and objective investments in staff development and technology as we serve Cochise County for a better tomorrow.






about us

Canyon Vista Medical Center was founded in 1963 as Western Baptist Osteopathic Hospital in the outskirts of Sierra Vista. As the community grew, the hospital grew with it and in 2015 opened its doors to the state-of-the-art facility we have today.

Designated Level III Trauma Center

Canyon Vista Medical Center is the first medical center in Cochise County to be designated as a Level III Trauma Center. As a Level III Trauma Center, Canyon Vista Medical Center has demonstrated an ability to provide prompt assessment, resuscitation, surgery, intensive care and stabilization of injured patients and emergency operations.

Elements of Level III Trauma Centers Include:

- 24-hour immediate coverage by emergency medicine physicians and the prompt availability of general surgeons and anesthesiologists.
- Incorporates a comprehensive quality assessment program
- Has developed transfer agreements for patients requiring more comprehensive care at a Level I or Level II
 Trauma Center.
- Provides back-up care for rural and community hospitals.
- · Offers continued education of the nursing and allied health personnel or the trauma team.
- Involved with prevention efforts and must have an active outreach program for its referring communities.
